Lighting for different activities...

In the kitchen, a technical room, the lighting should ensure a friendly atmosphere and provide enough brightness without shadow zones in the working areas.

height. Indirect lighting illuminates when directed towards a flat surface such as walls or ceilings, whereas dimmers match-up color tones and adapt to the daily rhythm.

Floor or articulated lamps are indispensable when reading and conversing on a sofa because they provide a considerable amount of direct light. This punctual lighting diffuses a bright beam when projected over a defined surface. The rays target an object or an area, creating a warm, intimate and calm atmosphere.

For the bedroom, a relaxing and warm area... it is best to avoid central lighting such as a recessed light fixture, because it would feel too aggressive. Floor lamps or sconces which feature a soft filtered light are much more flattering.

Good lighting can add charm and personality to a soulless room, provided you know how to select and adapt the lamps according to demands. Direct or indirect, punctual or diffused, artificial light should beautify interiors, modulate the volumes and remove small defects.
